

Term: "Diversity" rather than "multiculturalism" **Approach:** Top-down, government led policies


# **HISTORICAL CONTEXT**

Peru's approach to its minority populations has evolved since its founding – from forced integration to an acknowledgement of diversity to adopting policies of multiculturalism. The majority of Peru's recent efforts to reduce discrimination focus on its Afro-Peruvian minority through surveying existing inequalities and deriving action plans.

# DOMESTIC

- 2016-2020 National Development Plan for the Afro-Peruvian Population (PLANDEPA)
- 2018 action plan focused on "justice" for the Afro-Peruvian community
- 2019 bill (entitled No. 03793/2018-PE) adopted to "sanction racism and discrimination"
  - supported racialized victims of discrimination
  - raised awareness about domestic
